### Information and Timetable

The Blues Ski League will run over 2 nights this year, both one night events - Division 3 & 4 and one night for Division 1 & 2. The full league will run over one night, with prize giving at the end of each event.

**NIGHT 1 - Fri 10th Nov 2023 - Division 3 & 4 Racers**

**NIGHT 2 - Fri 24th Nov 2023 - Division 1 & 2 Racers**

We are inviting teams of 5 racers to compete in the one night event, rather than racers attending two nights of racing at Bellahouston, you will only attend one night. Each Division will have a clear criteria, in order that racers are well matched in each division and the competition remains fair.

**All Clubs will require to pick teams using the following -**

Division 1	Any Racer
Division 2	Any Racer
Division 3	Any racer U16 (including U10/12/14)
Division 4	Racers new to training, covering U10/U12/U14

## FORMAT & COURSES

The race will be run as a dual slalom, using start gates and finish timing. Teams will race in a league, racing each other in an individual and team event, gaining points. Points will be collated, and finals will be run in the event of a tie.

## RULES

Teams must comprise 5 competitors  
No competitor may represent more than one team

Senior teams must have 1 females  
Junior teams must supply DOB or racers

Teams must check in and complete racer sheets to the commentator by 6pm on race night  
Teams must compete in their designated running order in the individual event  
Teams may compete in any order for the team relay dual slalom event  
Teams mayfield a substitute  
Any teams considered to be abusing the spirit or rules of the league will be disqualified  
Skis must longer than chin height when the racer is standing in ski boots  
Teams must provide gatekeepers for the event  
Teams wishing to protest must do so in writing directly to the Event Organiser of the event, immediately after the event and pay £25. Only team managers and team captains may be present at protests. If protests are upheld the £25 will be refunded.

## Prize Giving

Prizes will be given to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each division, prizegiving will be outside, with each winning team presented separately. Medals and Trophy will be presented to the winning team, no other prizes will be presented. We are recognizing that since COVID times, businesses are not in a position to sponsor events with excessive prizes. **These events are being run for the joy of competition and staying active.**
