Development stages

- Stage 1 Developing skiers through the Club, learning the skills to move into early competition. Showing a proficient skill level and interest for GSR's Race Development and schools races.
- Stage 2 Introduction to the GSR Race
 Training programme on the artificial slope.
 This stage allows young skiers to further develop their skills and experience in racing in a safe and fun training environment with some grassroots competition..

- Stage 3 Moving through the GSR Race Training programme by developing skill level and racing experience on artificial slopes. At this point we are encouraging young racers to gain experience and develop those skills on snow.
- Stage 4 Participating in the GSR snow-based programme in Scotland and abroad. Aiming to participate in the major Alpine competitions and having long-term goals of achieving National Team selection..

Programme

HOME - GSR Training consists of weekly training sessions August to June with a Summer programme that includes race camps, Snow Factor training, Hillend training, gate training and fitness sessions. Providing a mixture of technical work, skills development and racing on the artificial slope in Bellahouston Park, Glasgow, all delivered by highly qualified coaches.

AWAY - GSR aim to deliver 8 camps away from the Club each year. These camps include a mixture of training camps abroad in the Alps and Indoor Slopes, along with race camps and race support to all the major Alpine events in the British Calendar.





British Indoor Champs Chillfactor, Manchester


16th & 17th July 2022

29th March 2023 - 8th April 2023


U10-U16 Championships - 3rd April - 7th April 2023.
