NOTES

- 1) Age should be taken as actual age on the day of race.
- 2) Events 10, 11 & 12 are **OPEN RACES** and will have all age groups together (Adults & Juniors) in a straight knockout situation.
- 3) All racers must wear a full racing helmet up to British Standards.
- 4) Juniors for the team event must be 12 years or under on the day of race.
- 5) Prizes for 1st - 5th in events 1 and 2
- 6) Prizes for 1st - 3rd in all other events
- 7) Trophy for the Overall Winner (male or female)
